Application Cover Sheet

A detailed research/study proposal of no more than 3 pages, maximum of 900 words. Emphasize how this will further the international studies of the student. Refer to the expected components on the website.

A list of references cited (not to exceed 1 page).

A proposed budget outlining the anticipated costs of the research/study. Budget must include a list of other potential funding sources, including any commitments from the student's home department.

A list with dates of any previous international travel experience, if applicable.

USC transcript (unofficial copies from my.sc.edu will be accepted).

Resume

2 letters of recommendation. The 1st letter needs to be from the faculty member/supervisor who is directly supervising the research. The 2nd letter needs to be from a faculty or scholar familiar with the student's work and travel plans.

Recommendation letters must be in a sealed envelope, signed on the back by the recommender or must be emailed directly to caswiis@mailbox.sc.edu

Note: Include any information about the programs or the research project in which you will participate in.
